Did you know....

It's always a good idea to purchase travel money before you leave so that you have cash on hand to handle your immediate expenses - like buying a meal in the airport or taking a cab to your hotel. This way you're not stranded without cash if the airport ATM isn't working or you arrive after the local exchange bureau has closed.

It is highly recommend to take along anywhere between \$100 to \$300 worth of foreign currency before you land at your destination.
